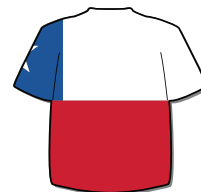

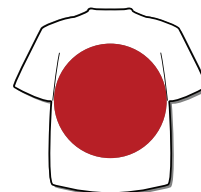

Hints and Tips for Organisers

- 1 In running an Office Sweepstake, we would suggest that you collect all money up front from entrants before the tournament.
- 2 If you have a small team at your office, you might consider selling two tickets for the price of one.
- 3 Avoid choosing your own team before others, colleagues may be less likely to enter if you have already picked a tournament favourite. (Consider nominating somebody else to pick your team for you).
- 4 Use the Team Player sheet enclosed to ensure clarity on who has picked which team, and whether or not they have paid.
- 5 Consider a prize for the worst team in the tournament (e.g. the team that scores the fewest or concedes the most goals) so that everyone's interest is maintained.
- 6 Please encourage participants to be responsible about gambling, and make them aware of relevant support initiatives (e.g. gambleaware.co.uk).
